## **Objectives and Tasks**

Accountable education unit is responsible for guiding, supervising and supporting accountable education programs and planning and implementing community-accountable training programs with the support of the Ministry of Health, the University, and the collaboration of the departments to enable the graduate to administer the health system of the country.

- 1. Active participation of the educational system and the service delivery system in identifying and assessing the community needs and determining priorities.
- 2. The presence of the educational system at all levels of the health service system
- 3. Participation of the educational system in reforming the health service system, providing innovations in the services supply in order to meet the needs
- 4. Reforming educational strategies and moving away from traditional educational boundaries
- 5. Developing an empowerment plan for faculty members on accountable education
- 6. Developing applied researches based on community needs and making a balance between basic science and clinical researches and researches on community needs and health promotion
- 7. Public education for disease prevention
- Establishing a suitable context for education in order to avoid unnecessary drugs
- II. Creating and increasing health knowledge in society through science generalization
  - 1. Education related to community needs
  - 2. Faculties with knowledge about community that teach community-related topics.
  - 3. Accessibility of health services providing center for people in which students provide health care.
  - 4. Capability building for students that is not possible within the university and specialized hospitals and the interaction abilities with the community.
  - 5. An opportunity to collaborate and interact with other health professionals and staff

- 6. Communication and collaboration among university, government and society
  - Promoting the quality of medical education in line with standards
  - Empowering existing human resources to provide the community health
  - Revision of the medical education curriculum in order to respond to the real needs of the community
  - Improving service provision indicators to achieve national standards in the field for medical students
  - Developing educational spaces in the field for medical students
  - Equipping training centers in the field
